To be eligible you must qualify under one of the provisions of Section 79 of the Local Government Act 1972, i.e.

- be on the electoral register for the Parish;
- have owned or rented land in the Parish for 12 months;
- have worked in the Parish for 12 months;
- have lived in the Parish or within 3 miles of the Parish boundary for 12 months;
- must be 18 years of age or over.
